RICE BRAN

DESCRIPTION:

RICE BRAN is the pericarp or bran layer and germ of the rice, with only such quantity of hull fragments, chipped, broken or brewer's rice and calcium carbonate as is unavoidable in the regular milling of edible rice. It must not contain not more than 13% fiber. When calcium carbonate exceeds 3% (Ca 1.2%), the percentage must be declared in the brand name. (Calcium carbonated added as a flow enhancer).

TYPICAL ANALYSIS: *

Crude Protein	14.0%
Fat	15.0%
Crude Fiber	12.0%
Moisture	9.0%

USE AND APPLICATION:

RICE BRAN is used largely in ruminant feeds or when fiber levels can be accommodated. Can be used in swine and poultry feeds in limited amounts.
