Rice Hulls

Product Description

Rice Hulls consist primarily of the outer covering of rice obtained during the regular milling of edible rice.

Storage and Handling

Rice Hulls are available in bulk and as such stored in traditional bulk bins and handled accordingly. Rice Hulls may be stored on a cement slab or in a commodity bay (covered and protected from the weather).

Use and Application

Rice Hulls are used mostly in feed requiring or accommodating high fiber levels.

Note: Digestibility of fiber is limited. Often used as a carrier in mineral and vitamin premixes or as a bedding material.
