Standard Operating Procedure



Step 1

Inspect all packaging to ensure all are intact.
50 pound bags with 40 bags per pallet or 2000 pound totes



Step 2

Store in a cool, dry place. Keep out of reach of children.



Step 3

Prior to use, put on appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), which may include, but not limited to:



- Eye/face protection
 - Safety glasses or chemical goggles
- Respiratory protection
 - If exposure limits are exceeded or irritation is experienced, NIOSH/MSHA approved respiratory protection should be worn



- Hearing protection
 - Earmuffs or ear plugs
- Head protection
 - Helmet, hood, hat, cap

Step 4

Measure appropriate amount.
