Standard Operating Procedure



Step 1

Inspect all bags to ensure all are intact. 50 pound bags with 40 bags per pallet



Step 2

Store in a cool, dry place. Keep out of reach of children.



Step 3

Prior to use, put on appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), which may include, but not limited to:

- Eye/face protection
